



Blakes Crossing Shopping Centre Privilege

Dear BCCC Families (of Year 11 and 12 students).

This is addressed to all year 11 and 12 students in an attempt to note and respect the difference in their needs and maturity. As part of the privileges for Year 11 and 12 students, we will be allowing them to go the shopping centre during breaks to purchase food.

The conditions and expectations around accessing the shops during break times are:

- Year 12 may access the shops, for the purpose of purchasing food, any day of the week
- Year 11 may access the shops, for the purpose of purchasing food on Friday at lunch only.
- Students are to use card or cash for purchases, and must not use their mobile phone.
- Any drinks purchased must only be juice or water. No soft drinks, milks, or anything else.
- Students need to walk to/from the shops carefully, using the EMU crossing on Boucaut Ave.
- When at the shopping centre, students need to be respectful and courteous of the public.
- All food and drink must be consumed prior to the commencement of the next lesson
- Students must not be late to class, and may not consume food or drink during class.
- Students must walk sraight to the shops and back. Students should not be consuming food at the shopping centre, or loitering / waiting for friends.
- Only students who have a returned consent form can enjoy this privilege.

Students who do not adhere to the above will have these privileges rescinded and may even be given detention. This is a privilege for Year 11 and 12 students ONLY.

Students who don't complete and return the form, will not be allowed to go to the shopping centre during break times.
